STEP 1: KNOW YOUR LEGISLATORS

Go to **NYAVR.org** to identify your state Senator and Assemblymember based upon your address. If more than one name comes up, use your full zip code.

STEP 2: WHERE DO YOUR LEGISLATORS STAND ON THESE IMPORTANT ISSUES?

We are working hard to pass two bills, Senate Bill S6141c and Assembly Bill A8123a. These bills are the same bill, one for the Senate and one for the Assembly. These bills will stop school districts from denying religious exemptions from vaccine mandates. This gross violation of human right happens in about 40 school districts in NY, and the number is growing. Help us pass these bills and assure your rights.

STEP 3: CONTACT YOUR LEGISLATORS AND BE SURE YOUR VOICE IS HEARD!

Call, email and mail letters to your legislators to be sure they know how critical vaccine rights are to you and your family. Ask them to co-sponsor Senate Bill S6141c and Assembly Bill A8123a.

These bills are the result of years of effort and literally hundreds of meetings with legislators, agencies and community groups, and getting the bills passed will take a huge effort. Every constituent must be sure their voice is heard!

STEP 4: SPREAD THE WORD

Ask your friends, family, contacts and social networks to join in the effort to protect their rights. Never underestimate what a small group of dedicated people can accomplish.

New York Legislation that threatens Your Rights:

- Senate Bill S52 and Assembly Bill A1810, eliminates your right to a religious exemption, just like California's SB 277
- Senate Bill S132 and Assembly Bill A933, requires all children to get shots for human papilloma virus (HPV)
- Senate Bill S5611 and Assembly Bill A 2469, allows children to receive shots for sexually-transmitted diseases without parental knowledge or consent
- Senate Bill 6346 and Assembly Bill A1230, requires all children in daycare to get annual flu shots
