Dear Mayor and Councilmembers [or county reps],

On behalf of _____, we respectfully submit the enclosed packet regarding the urgent need for local action in response to the FCC's proposed rulemaking under Docket 25-276 and the long-standing constraints placed on municipalities by Section 704 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.

This issue is both serious and time-sensitive. The FCC's proposal would dramatically expand federal preemption, reduce or eliminate local discretion, weaken public participation, and undermine essential land-use authority. Combined with Section 704—which has restricted local governments from considering environmental and human health impacts for nearly 30 years—these developments represent an unprecedented challenge to local governance and community self-determination.

We are not alone in voicing these concerns.

Both the League of California Cities [or name your state's orgs] and the National League of Cities have submitted formal opposition to the FCC's proposed rule changes, emphasizing the critical need to preserve local authority, public process, and the constitutional balance between federal and municipal governance.
